

10 Important Operation Tips

- 1) Insert Battery all the way down to hear a click sound and see the Release Button has popped up To prevent surge or tool power shut down during operation.
- 2) Never Tension or Seal without straps.
- 3) When using a new tool or using tool on new straps Do Not overset the tool, must Pre-test Tension in Manual Mode starting from a lower level, then change to Auto Mode to prevent scratches and slippage. Also Pre-test Sealing starting from a lower level to prevent over-melting the joint.
- 4) Must check tool is equipped with correct Strap Guides (front/rear), and must inserting straps completely within the Strap Guides (front/rear) To prevent insufficient tension or insufficient Seal.
- 5) Do not over trickle in Manual Tension mode To prevent slippage on strap and prevent residue buildups on the FeedWheel.
- 6) If tool slips on straps or fails to tension Must check and clean the FeedWheel and the Bottom Tension Grippers with air gun or with the enclosed brush completely before the next cycle. Please reduce tension setting and pre-test based on strap quality, specification and strength is necessary.
- 7) Press the Sealing Button all the way down in one direct motion to perform sealing.

 If tool fails to seal sufficiently Must check and clean the Bottom Seal Gripper to make sure there is free-range of movements.
- 8) After Seal, must wait for tool to finish cooling countdown before removing tool To prevent insufficient sealing efficiency.
- 9) Must lift the Operation lever all the way up before removing tool away from straps To prevent damaging the Side Cover and Rear Strap Guide Axis.
- 10) Remove Battery when tool is not in use.
